

Volunteer Procedure

The volunteer participating in the Collegiate Sports Club program is not an employee or agent of KSU for any purpose. Volunteers are not entitled to receive any compensation from KSU, including but not limited to, health care benefits; compensation benefits, vacation, sick time, or any other benefit of employment, direct or indirect. As a volunteer, you are not considered an "employee." Therefore, you are not eligible for workers' compensation benefits through Kennesaw State University. In the event of an injury requiring medical care, you or your personal health insurance will be responsible for payment of all medical care. Authorized Volunteers must abide by all applicable University policies.

1. Volunteer participants for KSU are not entitled to benefits including Workers' Compensation.
2. A statement below must be on file specifying job duties. The start and end date must be completed. The volunteer position may be terminated at any time.
3. The volunteer must abide by all applicable campus, including departmental, policies.
4. If a lawsuit is filed against an "authorized volunteer" alleging negligence, KSU has government immunity, and that volunteer is covered.
5. Participation in the Club Sports program is voluntary; therefore, monetary rewards or scholarships shall not be promised or given to any member or prospective member by the coach, or any designee.
6. A signed volunteer agreement must be on file agreeing to the policy.
